Mobilizing Against MAGA in North Carolina

Republicans in North Carolina have nominated their most extreme ticket yet. This year, voters will see Donald Trump, Mark Robinson, Dan Bishop, and Michele Morrow as Republican nominees, in addition to a number of other far-right candidates up and down the ballot.

These candidates stand in opposition to North Carolinian values and will make North Carolina a worse place to live and raise a family. We must educate voters about the threat these candidates pose and connect on our shared values of freedom, dignity, and equality.

Top Issue Contrasts

Abortion:

- Republican extremists would make abortion illegal in North Carolina with no exceptions, even when a woman is raped, the victim of incest, or may lose her life.
- Democrats believe North Carolinians deserve the freedom to decide if and when to start a family. They will defend reproductive rights – including the access to contraception, fertility treatments like IVF, and abortion – because women deserve the right to make decisions over their own bodies, families, and futures.

Education:

- Republican extremists want to defund public schools so that millionaires can send their children to private academies. Republican candidates have proposed eliminating science and history from elementary school curriculum, allowing teachers to carry guns in classrooms, and otherwise inserting politicians into our classrooms.
- Democrats want kids to have the freedom to learn, to be themselves, and to grow up healthy and safe in warm, welcoming schools. They will invest in our public schools now so we can provide more opportunities for our children and build a stronger economy and future for North Carolina.

Top Character Critiques

- ❖ Republican extremists have made numerous derogatory comments about women, LGBTQ people, Black people, and Jewish people showing that they would not be leaders for all North Carolinians.
- ❖ Republican extremists have spread dangerous conspiracy theories. Both Mark Robinson and Michele Morrow are election deniers and QAnon believers who have encouraged violence against their political opponents. Robinson is an avowed Holocaust denier and Morrow called for televised execution of President Obama.

REMINDER: When talking with voters, make sure they know about both a candidate's offensive rhetoric *and* their proposed policies so a full picture can be painted of both the candidate's character and the impact they could have on voters' lives when in positions of power.
